Westview High Named 2022 National Blue Ribbon School

Today, U.S. Secretary of Education Miguel Cardona recognized just 297 schools across the country, and 29 schools across California, as [National Blue Ribbon Schools](#) for 2022. The recognition is based on a school’s exemplary academic performance or progress in closing achievement gaps among students. Westview High School is one of the state’s highest performing schools as measured by state assessment.
